Volunteer Policy

Each family is being asked to volunteer a minimum of 5 hours per family (not per wrestler). There are two main events available to complete your hours. The Grant Schoen Beginners Tournament (2/10/19) and the Ozaukee County Fair Parking(7/31/19 - 8/4/19). 1-2 shifts at each or both events will cover the required hours. Sign up is done through SignUpGenius closer to the event dates.

Other volunteer opportunities that arise will be announced via email.

A buyout of \$75/family is available at the time of registration. Families that do not fulfill their hours by the end of August, will be invoiced \$75 in September.

There are a number of open Board positions. Any of the following positions would fulfill required hours.

Treasurer - Maintains the financial records of the club and prepare checks as directed by the board or President. The Treasurer shall make deposits and give a current financial report at each meeting. The Treasurer should be a signer on all checks issued on behalf of the club.

Matpup and Jr. Matdog Coordinator - Liaison between families and the club. Keep an updated roster/email list.

Fundraiser Coordinator - Working with the board, solicit donors, follow up on ideas for fundraisers, keep track of donors and donations, and help coordinate fundraising events.

Beginners Tournament Coordinator - Oversee the planning and execution of the tournament using the planning guide.

Special Event Coordinator - Help plan team outings and end of season awards banquet.
